ORDINANCE NO. 21-1308-0716#8A

ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance of General Obligation Refunding Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source) of the Chicago Park District, Cook and DuPage Counties, Illinois, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$50,000,000 pursuant to the Local Government Debt Reform Act of the State of Illinois, as amended, for the purpose of refunding outstanding alternate bonds of the District

WHEREAS, the Chicago Park District, Cook and DuPage Counties, Illinois (the "District"), is a duly organized and existing park district created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Park District Code of the State of Illinois, as amended (the "Park Code"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the District (the "Board") has heretofore issued and has outstanding its General Obligation Unlimited Tax Refunding Bonds, Series 2011C (Personal Property Replacement Tax Alternate Revenue Source), dated September 29, 2011 (the "Outstanding Bonds"); and

WHEREAS, the Board has further determined that it is advisable, necessary and in the best interests of the District to refund all or a portion of the Outstanding Bonds (the "Refunding") in order to restructure the debt burden of the District or realize interest rate savings; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the Refunding, including engineering, legal, financial, bond discount, printing and publication costs and other expenses will not exceed \$50,000,000, and there are insufficient funds on hand and lawfully available to pay such costs; and

WHEREAS, the Board has further determined that it is advisable and necessary that the Refunding be undertaken and, in order to raise the funds required to pay such costs, that the District borrow an amount not to exceed \$50,000,000 and, in evidence thereof, issue General Obligation Refunding Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source) in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$50,000,000 (the "Bonds"), in accordance with the provisions of Section 15 of the Local Government Debt Reform Act of the State of Illinois, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the principal of and interest on the Bonds will be payable from the "Pledged Replacement Taxes," being those amounts allocated and paid to the District from the Personal Property Tax Replacement Fund of the State of Illinois pursuant to Section 12 of the State Revenue Sharing Act of the State of Illinois, as amended, or from such successor or replacement fund or act as may be enacted in the future, remaining after any required allocation thereof to provide for the payment of those claims, currently for certain pension or retirement obligations and for certain aquarium and museum purposes, that are required to be paid from the Personal Property Replacement Tax Revenues prior to any other application or use thereof pursuant to Section 12 of said State Revenue Sharing Act, or such successor or replacement act as may be enacted in the future (the "Pledged Revenues"); and

WHEREAS, if the Pledged Revenues are insufficient to pay the Bonds, ad valorem property taxes upon all taxable property in the District without limitation as to rate or amount are authorized to be extended to pay the principal of and interest on the Bonds:

Now, Therefore, Be It and It Is Hereby Ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the Chicago Park District, Cook and DuPage Counties, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Incorporation of Preambles. The Board hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and does incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

Section 2. Determination to Issue Bonds. It is necessary and in the best interests of the District to undertake the Refunding and the Bonds are hereby authorized to be issued and sold for that purpose.

Section 3. Publication. This Ordinance, together with a notice in the statutory form, shall be published in the Chicago Sun Times, the same being a newspaper of general circulation in the District, and if no petition, signed by 118,821 electors, the same being equal to the greater of (i) 7.5% of the number of registered voters in the District or (ii) 200 of those registered voters or 15% of those registered voters, whichever is less, asking that the issuance of the Bonds be submitted to referendum, is filed with the Secretary of the Board within thirty (30) days after the date of the publication of this Ordinance and said notice, then the Bonds shall be authorized to be issued.

Section 4. Additional Ordinances. If no petition meeting the requirements of applicable law is filed during the petition period hereinabove referred to, then the Board may adopt additional ordinances or proceedings supplementing or amending this Ordinance providing for the issuance and sale of the Bonds and prescribing all the details of the Bonds, so long as the maximum amount of the Bonds as set forth in this Ordinance is not exceeded and there is no material change in the purposes described herein. Such additional ordinances or proceedings shall in all instances become effective immediately without publication or posting or any further act or requirement. This Ordinance, together with such additional ordinances or proceedings, shall constitute complete authority for the issuance of the Bonds under applicable law.

Section 5. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 6. Repealer. All ordinances or orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, and that this Ordinance be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption.
