WHEREAS, the Chicago Park District takes great pleasure and pride in recognizing its employees who have dedicated numerous years of service to the Park District and the City of Chicago; and

WHEREAS, Timothy Later has greatly contributed to the Park District's goals, and exemplifies the meaning of hard work, commitment, and passion to the District and City of Chicago as a valued employee; and

WHEREAS, he received his Master's in Urban Planning and Policy from the University of Illinois at Chicago and worked as Executive Director of the Near West Side Community Development Corporation; and
